### 1. Planning

14/02934/FUL Mr Johnson – The Fields, West Lane

It was agreed the following letter be sent to DMBC Planning:

The parish council would like to bring some observations and consideration on the above planning.

- The variation plans show a wrought iron gate, the one fitted is actually a solid wood electric gate. Is this gate to be changed or is the variation incorrect?
- There is currently various lighting on the walls which has no plans submitted for originally or on the variation. The lights are shining bright onto the dark lane making it appear if something is stationary on the road or approaching the oncoming traffic, something the Parish Council feel is very dangerous.
- The static home/caravan is not in the original position as per the plans.

In the original planning it was stated Mr Johnson had to put plans together for Lighting, Fencing, Gates and Walls, this is still not been applied for on this variation planning application.

The variation and original plans are completely different from what works have already been done, none of which look in keeping with the village and its surroundings. The Parish Council feel that all planning should be treated fairly and equally.

### 2. Other

A Bench in the village had been knocked down recently and was now in need of replacement. Clerk to look into this to see if this is covered under the current insurance policy.

The gate on the village green is in need of urgent repairs/renewal. It was agreed a quotation would be required and considered. This may need to be sorted before the next meeting, which will be considered by email if a decisions needs to be made.
